## CHILD SEATS FOR PLANES AND BUSES

Whether or not it is obligatory, children will be safer both on flights and on buses if they are in a restraint system properly suited for their height, weight and age

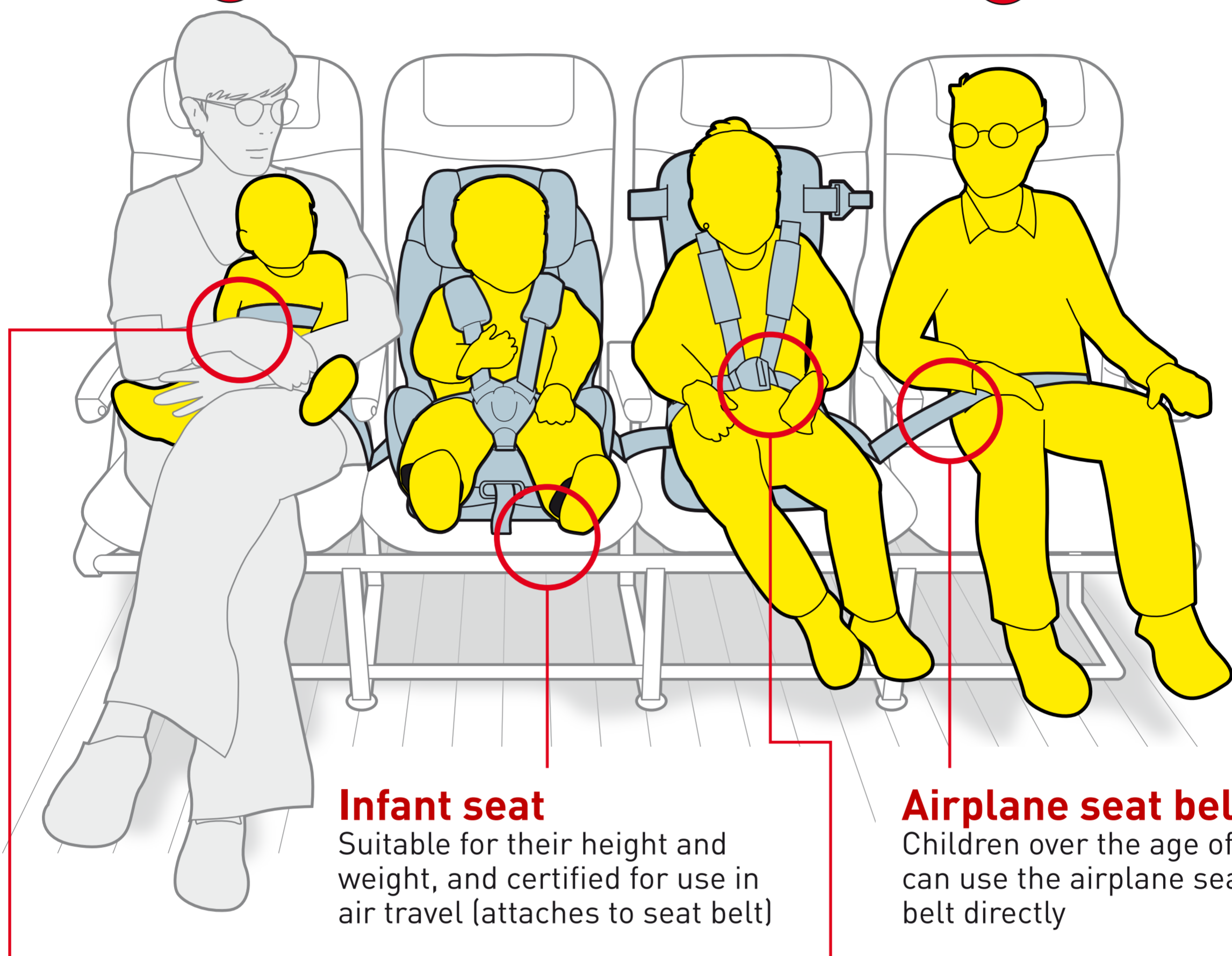
### Air travel

#### Infant seat

Suitable for their height and weight, and certified for use in air travel (attaches to seat belt)

#### Airplane seat belt

Children over the age of 4 can use the airplane seat belt directly

#### Harness belt for infants

Attaches to the parent's seat belt, and the parent holds the infant in their lap

#### CARES harness

This system attaches to the regular airplane seat belt and provides four points of support

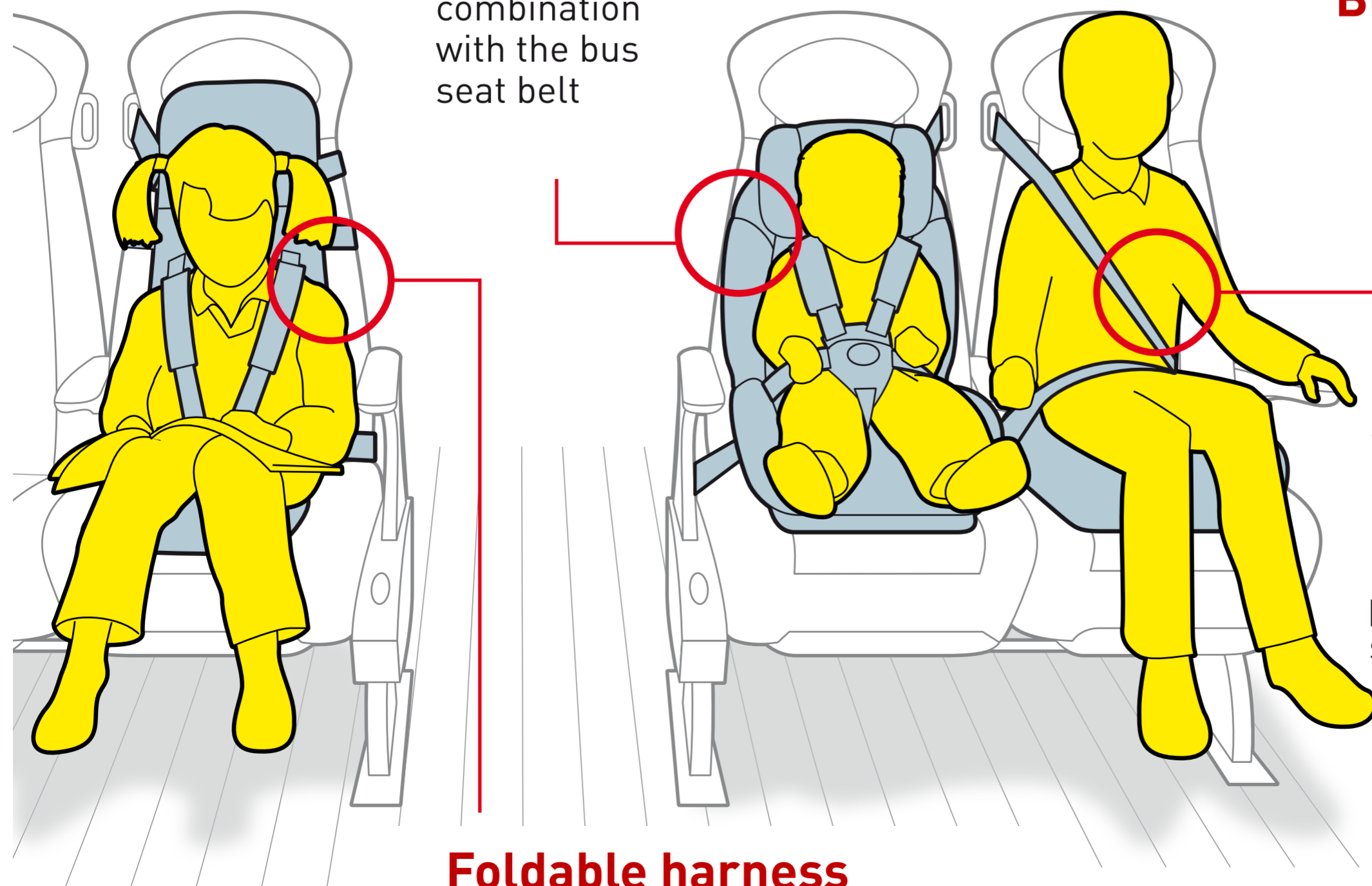

#### Infant seat

Suitable for their height and weight, and works in combination with the bus seat belt

#### Bus seat belt

Children can use two-point seat belts



If the bus has three-point seat belts, children must sit on a booster seat or, preferably, a car seat adapted for their height

#### Foldable harness

A foldable harness can be attached to the seat and to the vehicle's seat belt
