

LARGE FAMILIES - WAYS TO TRAVEL BY CAR

2
CHILDREN

On the rear seats and they must be in a child car seat.

In 9-seater vehicles, young children who are less than 135 cm tall must travel on the rear seats and use a child car seat suitable for their size and weight..

Exceptions:

- If the vehicle does not have any rear seats.
- If all the rear seats are occupied by other young children in child car seats.
- If a CRS cannot be installed on these seats.



3 children with child car seats on the rear seats

3
CHILDREN

2 children on the rear seats and one in the passenger seat

- This is difficult in a 5-seater car if all of them are using a CRS.

- No child car seat should be pushing against another.

- It is easier if one is a booster seat or if one of the children no longer needs a child car seat.

- If it is impossible to install 3 child car seats on the rear seats: 2 children on the rear seats and one in the passenger seat.

- Only when the rear seats are being used by young children with a child car seat.



You must deactivate the airbag, especially if the child car seat is rear-facing.



4
CHILDREN

Place three child car seats next to each other on the rear seats and one on the passenger seat

- Three child car seats on the rear seats and one on the passenger seat (preferably the oldest child).

- Only in large vehicles such as minivans. Up to 6 children can travel in this kind of vehicle.



We should take into account that the number of people being transported in a vehicle cannot be higher than the number of seats authorised.

In a 5-seater vehicle only 4 children can travel in it. If we travel in a minivan with 7 seats, only 6 children may travel in it.
