Fundación **MAPFRE**

Fundación MAPFRE is a private non-profit organisation whose aim is to contribute to the achievement of general interest objectives, including the promotion of research and the dissemination of knowledge in relation to insurance and social welfare.

Fundación MAPFRE created the Julio Castelo Matrán International Insurance Award as a tribute to Julio Castelo Matrán, former President of MAPFRE and a great promoter of its development. The award is aimed at recognising scientific papers and innovative projects on subjects related to insurance and social welfare.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE 2023 CALL FOR ENTRIES

Fundación MAPFRE has announced the **Julio Castelo Matrán International Insurance Award** to recognise outstanding scientific papers related to insurance and social welfare. This award is granted every two years and has now reached its 11th edition.

The award shall be subject to the following terms and conditions:

ONE

The Julio Castelo Matrán International Insurance Award is international in scope.

It is open to individuals and organisations that have carried out significant scientific research whose results contribute to extending insurance activity in society and promoting economic stability and solidarity through insurance and/or social welfare.

Consideration will be given to:

- Unpublished scientific papers or papers published in the last four years (taking as a reference the date specified in clause Seven) that provide knowledge on insurance and/or social welfare.
- The transferability of the work to other countries or regions.

TWO

A jury appointed by Fundación MAPFRE will be responsible for evaluating the applications and deciding on the finalists and their order. The jury shall have the following powers:

- To verify the information on the applications submitted by any means it deems appropriate.
- To declare the award void if the applications submitted do not meet the minimum requirements established in the call for entries.
- To disqualify the winner and designate a substitute should the winner fail to attend the prize-giving ceremony.
- To make the appropriate decisions in order to interpret these terms and conditions, which are considered to be accepted by the candidates simply by virtue of their participation in the award ceremony.

THREE

The decisions of the jury shall be final and, at the suggestion of the jury, Fundación MAPFRE may declare the award void if the candidates do not meet the required level of expectation.

FOUR

The prize shall be awarded in July 2023 and shall be publicised on the Fundación MAPFRE website and in any other media deemed appropriate.

The award will be presented in 2023 at a public event to be announced in due course.

The winning person, organisation or, in the case of co-authored papers, the representative of the application, if any, undertakes to attend the award ceremony in person, as well as to:

- Provide graphic materials (with copyright licence) for the announcement of the award and the design of the prize-giving ceremony.
- Carry out the scheduled interviews with the media at least the day before and the day of the award ceremony.

Failure to comply with these requirements may be grounds for disqualification as a winner at the discretion of Fundación MAPFRE. The prize shall then go to the next selected finalist.

FIVE

Neither the jury nor Fundación MAPFRE is required to correspond with any of the candidates or to return the originals of the papers or reports submitted, which, in the event of not winning, will be destroyed in accordance with the terms stated in clause Thirteen.

SIX

Individuals who have carried out scientific research as authors or institutions owning a collective work containing a scientific paper related to any of the subjects covered by this award may participate in this call for entries by submitting their application in accordance with the established rules.

Scientific papers may be submitted in co-authorship. In these cases, it will be sufficient to submit a single application with the name of the representative, who will act on behalf of the applicants and as the contact person for the organisation of the award. All references to the candidate or winner (natural person) in these terms and conditions shall be understood to refer to each of the co-authors unless otherwise stated. This person or organisation shall be responsible for having previously obtained written authorisation from the other co-owners of the intellectual property rights over the scientific paper in order to submit it for this award

and to be able to assume, on behalf of all of them, the commitments set out in these terms and conditions.

The same candidate may submit or participate in several papers as a co-author, each of which will require a separate application.

If the winning paper is co-authored, all authors will be awarded equally.

Applications and supporting documents must be submitted in Spanish, English or Portuguese by the candidates themselves using the following procedure:

Until 11:59 p.m. (Spanish time UTC+2) on 31 May 2023, applications must be submitted online via the form available at www.fundacionmapfre.org/en/, attaching the following documents:

- A summary of the scientific paper of up to 2,000 words, highlighting the contributions made by the candidate. If the paper is co-authored, all co-authors must be acknowledged.
- The scientific paper **itself in electronic format (19 Mb maximum size)**.

SEVEN

All scientific papers submitted for this eleventh edition must have been carried out by the candidate after May 2019.

EIGHT

Employees of any organisation belonging to MAPFRE and their immediate family members up to the second degree of consanguinity or affinity are not eligible to participate in this call for entries.

NONA

Candidates shall be liable for the veracity of the documents submitted. Scientific papers must be original. Their submission alone is considered to be a full declaration of their authenticity. Candidates shall be liable for the veracity of the documents submitted. Scientific papers must be original. Their submission alone is considered to be a full declaration of their authenticity. Candidates must have, from the time of application, all the necessary rights and licences to grant Fundación MAPFRE, in the event of being awarded a prize, the free public dissemination of the scientific paper submitted under the terms indicated in clause Eleven.

Papers may have been published in the last 4 years, taking as a reference the date specified in clause Seven.

Furthermore, all candidates undertake to produce the original or a certified copy of any of the documents provided in their application, at the request of Fundación MAPFRE.

TEN

The gross amount of the prize is **€30,000** and is subject to the tax and money laundering prevention regulations in force in Spain.

Pursuant to the requirements established by the Spanish Prevention of Money Laundering and the Terrorist Financing Act (Art. 2 of Law 10/2010 of 18 April 2010) and its implementing regulations (RD 304/2014), the prize-winner is required to submit to Fundación MAPFRE any documents requested by the latter in compliance with the aforementioned Act, as a prerequisite for the awarding of the prize.

The winner must submit the necessary documents for formal identification as a natural person or organisation (including, where applicable, the identification of the owner of the recipient organisation and its representative):

- The identity card/passport and tax identification number of the winner or representative of the winner (which must match the signatory of the donation certificate). In the case of co-authorships, all references to the candidate (natural person) must be understood to refer to each of the co-authors, unless otherwise specified. Therefore, all of them must submit their identity document, passport or identity card. The documents submitted must be in force.
- If the winner is a legal entity, a copy of a notarised affidavit of ownership identifying the owner of the winning organisation.
- Failing the above (only for foreign organisations that do not have a document equivalent to an affidavit of ownership), a copy of the company's articles of incorporation, its registration in the public registers of its country, its tax identification number, its current bylaws and a sworn statement from the owner (the owners of the organisation or, failing this, the members of its governing bodies, duly identified by their identity documents) signed by an authorised representative before a notary public or with a notarised signature.
- A copy of the Power of Attorney of the representative of the winner who signs the donation certificate.
- A certificate from the bank regarding the ownership of the account for the payment of the prize in the name of the winner.
- A sworn declaration of the validity of the information contained in the above-mentioned documents.

The aforementioned documents must be submitted prior to the payment of the prize.

Failure to submit them in full or in part will result in the finalist renouncing the prize.

Fundación MAPFRE reserves the right to request any other additional documents relating to the above aspects and/or for the documents to be authenticated by a notary public, where appropriate.

ELEVEN

By accepting the prize, the authors and, where applicable, the other holders of the intellectual property rights of the winning research work in accordance with the Spanish Intellectual Property Act (RDL 1/1996 of 12 April 1996), expressly authorise Fundación MAPFRE, without any time limit, to proceed with the worldwide publication in any language and in any media it deems appropriate of the summary of the winning scientific paper, which must not exceed 2,000 words and must highlight the contributions made.

In the case of unpublished papers, upon acceptance of the prize, Fundación MAPFRE is expressly authorised by their authors to publish their full content, with the aim of disseminating the results of the research to the general public as one of its fundamental purposes. Fundación MAPFRE reserves the rights to edit, transform, publish and disseminate them worldwide, during the copyright protection period, in any language and in any format (analogue or digital), in particular, for their public dissemination by making them available on the Internet.

TWELVE. PRIVACY AND DATA PROTECTION

By registering for this call for entries, the candidate is informed of and expressly consents to the processing of the data provided voluntarily for this call for entries, as well as any other data that he/she may provide to Fundación MAPFRE and any data obtained by recording images or telephone conversations or as a result of his/her browsing on the Internet or other media, in connection with the application for or participation in the **Julio Castelo Matrán International Insurance Award** (hereinafter, the Activity). This shall also apply once the relationship has ended, including, where appropriate, any disclosure or international transfer of data for the purposes detailed in the Additional Information.

Should the data provided refer to third parties other than the candidate, the latter guarantees that he/she has obtained their prior consent for the disclosure of their data and has informed them, prior to their inclusion in this document, of the purposes of the processing, disclosure and other terms set forth herein and in the Additional Information on Data Protection.

Fundación MAPFRE reserves the right to require the candidate to verify consent at any time, in accordance with data protection guarantees, when personal data of third parties other than the interested party appear in the works and/or media resulting from participating in this call for entries.

The candidate declares that he/she is over eighteen years of age and guarantees the accuracy and veracity of the personal data provided, undertaking to keep them duly updated and to inform Fundación MAPFRE of any changes to such data.
